Jim Wallace is a cold case detective who developed a forensic method for analyzing eye witness accounts and interrogations to determine if the person is telling the truth. He was challenged to apply his technique to the Gospels and by doing so, he became a Christian. His website is filled with resources and videos. His books:

Cold Case Christianity — Establishing the truthfulness of the Gospel accounts.

God's Crime Scene — Shows overwhelming evidence for a Creator, the God of the Bible.

Forensic Faith — How to share your faith in a hostile culture

Lights in the Sky and Little Green Men — Hugh Ross, Kenneth Samples, and Mark Clark covers the possible existence of life from other worlds and the truth behind UFOs.

The Creator and the Cosmos by Hugh Ross — Evidence for the existence of the God of the Bible from scientific discoveries about the nature of our universe. 4th Edition. Is readily accessible but has a lot of science.

Set Apart: How Genesis Stands Apart by J. R. Miller In Set Apart: How Genesis Stands Alone, RTB fellow and visiting scholar, J.R. Miller, skillfully breaks down lofty theological truths and terms, presenting the reader with a valuable foundation. He then builds on that foundation, revealing the uniqueness of Genesis as theo-history. He further demonstrates how Hebrew cosmology offers a dependable foundation for knowing something true about our origins, shaping ethical priorities, directing moral decision making, and guiding scientific inquiry.

Rescuing Inerrancy by Hugh Ross — This book combats the modern tendency to reduce the Bible to mere allegory and NOT a historical account of the workings of God.

Weathering Climate Change by Hugh Ross — In Weathering Climate Change, astronomer Hugh Ross steps outside of the rancor and noise, offering a comprehensive look not only at Earth's current climate but also at the planet's captivating climate history. His measured perspective and realistic response are grounded in a wealth of evidence from multiple scientific disciplines.
